Setting these goals at the start of the year helps to ensure that students will maintain graduation pace by passing 60% of the year's courses. Focusing on the core subjects that are required for four full years establishes a baseline of core content for Academic Success.

February Narrative: The first half of the year had a number of programmatic challenges that made mastery of courses harder for students and staff. This involved a number of staff leaves for various reasons (maternity, paternity, surgery) and some shuffling of staff to ensure licensure in core classes. In addition there was an influx of off-track students that enrolled, leading to cultural shifts in the program itself. With that in mind the overall course completion was still at 60%, with teachers stating they saw a trend for stronger improvement as the trimester went on.
