A Parent's Guide to Understanding Contingency Learning Plans

The Contingency Learning Plan (CLP) was developed as a result of COVID-19 and is an individualized plan for students with disabilities which aligns as closely as possible to the IEP in providing a Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) in a remote learning setting or during a school closure. CLPs should be provided to all students with an IEP and based on a parent or district decision to learn remotely or in the event of a school closure. Remote learning is defined where the student and

teacher are not physically present in a traditional classroom environment. Information is mostly relayed through technology.

Contingency Learning Plans should be identified in the IEP and supports students and/or districts moving in and out of remote learning due to COVID and related quarantine requirements. If a CLP is not developed, the IEP must be implemented as written or an IEP amendment would need to occur that supports the district's offer of FAPE during the time that the student is moving in and out of school.



Contingency Learning Plans developed for the 2020-21 school year should align to the IEP to the extent possible in a remote learning format. The CLP identifies various activities and related services to support the individualized needs of the student. It will also document the collaboration with the parent to determine the frequency and duration of services needed in light of the current circumstance.
